Brief description of Project and Services Provided:

This was a complex project to install the state of the art CCTV system within an existing submarine which involved careful planning and close liaison with the client team to ensure that we delivered the services to the quality standards and procedures set by Merseytravel.

The World War II German U-boat was formerly a star attraction at the Historic Warships Museum at Seacombe docks near Birkenhead. Merseytravel, the local transport consortium, has bought the U-534 sub and it will sit at the Woodside Ferry Terminal as a tourist attraction. The sub has been cut into 4 sections each weighing 240 tons enabling visitors to explore the insides. The site includes a visitor exhibition centre, which includes artefacts from the submarine along with its history.
